

## Instructions for setting up an automatic scrape/spider of a corporate job board

An automatic scrape will allow your jobs to be automatically added/deleted/updated to the Make Golf Your Career Job Board without you having to touch them. Simply update your corporate portal and the system will do the rest of the work.

- Visit https://makegolfyourcareer.org
- Click on *Employers* at the top right of the homepage
- Select *My Company* from the drop-down menu & create your Company Account login credentials

An email will be sent from Make Golf Your Career Job Board confirming that your account has been established. Once you are in the system, you will also be able to build out your Company Directory page, add colleagues/team members that will have access to your company portal, etc. from the My Company page.

- Complete the Spider Items and Mapping worksheets within this workbook.
- Return the completed workbook to **YMPartnerReps@CommunityBrands.com**. Automatic scrapes take approximately two weeks to be set up.
